DESCRIPTION OF PROGRAM SERVICE ONE

BENIN -- AFTER EMERGING AS A WINNER IN THE 2006 GLOBAL DEVELOPMENT MARKETPLACE COMPETITION, SPONSORED BY WORLD BANK, SELF BEGAN IMPLEMENTING A GROUNDBREAKING PILOT PROJECT TO INSTALL LOW-COST DRIP IRRIGATION SYSTEMS AND SOLAR PUMPS IN TWO VILLAGES IN NORTHERN BENIN, WEST AFRICA. DUE TO THE DEVASTATING EFFECTS OF BENIN'S SIX-MONTH DRY SEASON, MANY FAMILIES SUFFER FROM POOR DIETS AND LITTLE INCOME DUE TO THEIR RELIANCE ON SUBSISTENCE FARMING. IN 2007, SELF, COLLABORATING WITH A LOCAL NGO THE ASSOCIATION POUR LE DEVELOPPEMENT ECONOMIQUE, SOCIAL ET CUTLUREL DE KALALØ (ADESCKA), BEGAN INSTALLING LOW-COST MICRO-IRRIGATION AND SOLAR WATER PUMPS IN TWO VILLAGES WHICH WILL RESULT IN PARTICIPATING FAMILIES DOUBLING THEIR HARVEST AND CONSUMPTION OF FRESH VEGETABLES DURING THE DRY SEASON, PROVIDING THE COMMUNITY WITH CLEAN WATER FOR DRINKING AND DOMESTIC USE, AND MUCH MORE.

RWANDA - PIH -- SELF IN COLLABORATION WITH THE BOSTON, MASSACHUSETTS-BASED NONPROFIT PARTNERS IN HEALTH (PIH) AND THE CLINTON FOUNDATION PROVIDED FIVE HEALTH CENTERS IN THE EASTERN PROVINCE OF RWANDA WITH SOLAR POWER SYSTEMS. IN A HOSPITAL SETTING, WHERE PROCEDURES ARE CONDUCTED ALL THE TIME, RELIABLE POWER IS PARAMOUNT. SELF DESIGNED HYBRID SYSTEMS THAT RELY ON SOLAR TO MEET 90 PERCENT OR MORE OF THE CLINIC'S NEEDS, WITH GENERATORS PROVIDING BACK-UP POWER DURING PROLONGED PERIODS OF RAIN OR EXTRA HEAVY ELECTRICITY USAGE. THIS IS THE FIRST TIME SELF EXTENDED SOLAR TECHNOLOGY TO SUPPLY SUCH LARGE AMOUNTS OF ELECTRICITY. THESE SYSTEMS SUPPLY ELECTRICITY FOR STATE-OF-THE-ART LABORATORIES, REFRIGERATION, COMPUTER RECORDKEEPING AND COMMUNICATION, INCLUDING SATELLITE DISHES TO TRANSMIT DATA.

BURUNDI AND LESOTHO -- COLLABORATING WITH BURUNDI-BASED VILLAGE HEALTH WORKS (VHW), AND ONCE AGAIN PARTNERS IN HEALTH (VHW), SELF SPENT MUCH OF ITS TIME IN 2007 ASSESSING LOGISTICS AND RAISING FUNDS FOR SOLAR ELECTRIFYING CLINICS IN THESE TWO VERY SMALL, DESTITUTE COUNTRIES. BURUNDI HAS A PUBLIC HEALTH CRISIS AND IS ADDRESSING THIS PROBLEM BY CONSTRUCTING A MODERN HEALTH CENTER THAT WILL ULTIMATELY SERVE 60,000 PEOPLE. LESOTHO, A SMALL, MOUNTAINOUS NATION OF 2 MILLION PEOPLE, SUFFERS FROM THE 3RD HIGHEST RATE OF HIV INFECTION IN THE WORLD. SELF'S MISSION IS TO PROVIDE SOLAR

ELECTRIC POWER TO BURUNDI'S NEWS CLINIC, AS WELL AS FOUR CLINICS IN LESOTHO.

SOUTH AFRICA -- WITH FUNDING FROM THE KELLOGG FOUNDATION AND JP MORGAN CHASE FOUNDATION, SELF SPENT MUCH OF 2007 PREPARING TO INSTALL SOLAR POWER AND INTERNET COMMUNICATIONS TO TWO THOUSAND STUDENTS AT 3 OFF-GRID SCHOOLS LOCATED IN THE EASTERN CAPE PROVINCE OF SOUTH AFRICA. ELECTRICAL LIGHTING WILL ALLOW FOR MORE INTENSIVE USE OF SCHOOL FACILITIES IN THE EVENING. ACCESS TO THE INTERNET PROVIDED THROUGH A SOLAR POWERED A WI-FI MESH NETWORK, GIVES STUDENTS AN ENTIRE TO UNIVERSE OF LEARNING RESOURCES.
